General Information

General Facilities:

Most of the rooms are dormitory style, multiple occupancy. There are only a few standard rooms for two or more persons with private baths at additional cost. A limited number of rooms are also available in Bayview Lodge at additional cost.

You may request a Bayview or standard room with bath by checking the appropriate line on the registration form. Elderly persons, families with small children, and those with special needs will be given priority for these rooms. Remaining rooms will be assigned on a first come-first served basis.

Several motels are located near the conference grounds. House rentals may be available. If you would like off-site lodging information, please check the appropriate line on the registration form.

Children:

Classes and activities will be provided for children age 4 through Grade 12. Teachers, craft workers, and supervisors for games and videos are needed. Please check the appropriate line on the registration form if you would like to help.

Nurseries will be provided for infants through children 3 years of age. Parental participation will be required. Help from others attending the conference will be appreciated. Please check the appropriate line on the registration form if you will use the nursery or if you would like to help.

Go east about 26 miles to Long Beach Island. Follow directions A, B, C.	<p>From North:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Take Garden State Parkway South to Exit 63.Take Route 72 East about 8 miles to Long Beach Island. Follow directions A, B, C. <hr/> <p>A. Proceed straight to the "T" intersection and make a left turn onto Long Beach Island Boulevard.</p> <p>B. Go about 4 miles (through Ship Bottom and Surf City) to the blinking traffic light in Harvey Cedars.</p> <p>C. Turn left onto Camden Avenue. Take the first left onto Cedars Ave. Follow signs to the conference grounds.</p>
